Potato plants grown up successfully and the time came to pick up the potatoes








Actually our potatoes weren't too big but totally biological!

The Environmental Education Directorate of our Prefecture prepared and implemented a large scale project of providing special ("yellow – blue") bins to every school, as to encourage all students and staff to recycle all the waste **papers** of schools. (it is additional to the normal blue bins about all kinds of paper)

A special seminar was given to all teachers of how to deal with this special bin with details on how to use it.

Also directions given by a handbook and promotional materials.

Such a bin has been situated in the yard of our school and students are taught about the procedures of paper recycling.

Results of this project will be measured and published in a special edition.

The Patras Municipality is also supporting this initiative by managing the waste papers of the bins.

Informative meeting of all the staff and the students of the nursery and primary special schools about how to use the special bin.




